#### Lord of the Flies - William Golding

Published in the year World War II, *Lord of the Flies* is a classic coming-of-age novel. Drawing from the rich tradition of Western literature, the coming-of-age allegory incorporates the foundations of Judeo-Christian myth to explain the "loss of innocence" that is at the heart of coming-of-age and maturity. A loss of innocence comes when knowledge is gained about the true, and often harsh, nature of the world. It can also be viewed as a geopolitical allegory reflecting the division of the world following WWII. The primary characters can be seen as Freudian allegory of the various stages of man's moral development.

- Themes of the novel include:
  - Coming-of-age and loss of innocence
  - The inherent nature of man as "savagery"
  - The role of war and violence in the lives of young men

- Upon completing the novel, students should be able to:
  - Recognize the significance of narration and point of view.
  - Identify the basic historical and religious allusions, which are integral to the novel's theme.
  - Explain how the novel functions as a Christian allegory for man's loss of innocence and coming-of-age.
